

February 1792

Came into Court Ann Morrison, d/o Joseph Morrison, dec'd, above 14 years, & chose Thomas McGaughey as her guardian, along with George Woods, jr. Approved.

23 April 1792

Came into Court Richard, Benjamin & Ann Corell, minor children of William Corrall, dec'd, Providence Twp, all being over 14 years of age, & chose Jacob Correll as guardian. Approved.

7 October 1792

Came into Court George Ellinger, minor child of John Ellinger, dec'd, above age 14, & chose George Funk & Conrod Hite as guardians. Approved.

19 November 1791

Came into Court Peter Ankeny & Casper Statler, executors of Michael Walters, dec'd, and reported a balance in the estate of £115/14/8, after lawful debts were paid; to be distributed according to the will.

Upon the petition of Michael Stall, eldest son of Henry, late of Franklin Co, dec'd, that his father died intestate, seized 3 tracts of land lying in Belfast Twp, that petitioner's father left 6 sons & 2 daughters & 1 grandson, namely: Michael, your petitioner; Leonard; Henry; John; Daniel; Jacob; Susannah & Barbara, intermarried with John Hicks; & Henry Hockersmith, grandson and that petitioner is entitled to 2 tracts of 10 tracts owned & that if the tracts cannot be divided, to make just appraisement thereof for distribution.

Whereupon the Court recognized the rights of those named & warned the High Sheriff that the rights of such children as were minors must be protected. The Sheriif to appraise the land tracts.

28 January 1793

Came into Court, John Hess & John Idenmyer & Dorothy, his wife, that John Hess & said Dorothy are administrators of Henry Biddinger, dec'd. It appears that a balance in the estate exists of £35/14/9 to be distributed according to the will.

Upon application by Memorial of Jacob Glassner, jr, and on motion of W. Nawgle, the Court appointed Jacob Glassner, jr, & George Burket as joint guardians over John, Peggy, Sally & Susannah Foust, minor children of Peter Foust, dec'd, in place of Michael Ingle, late guardian. Ordered.

August 1792

Came into Court Mary Gibson, admistrator of estate of William Gibson, dec'd, in which estate there appears to be a balance of £53/16/3 and petitioner desired that £17/18/9 be released to pay William Zinn & Elizabeth, his wife, £11/19/2 and that she pay Ann & Margaret Gibson £11/19/2 each, being their respective shares. [Elizabeth Zinn was evidently a married d/o William Gibson]
