And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said three daughters Christianna, Catharine & Lydia, to be the Executors of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament; In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this Fourth day of September Anno Domini eighteen hundred and fifty seven.
