J. M. Meredith died at his residence on N. Kan. Ave., at 9 o'clock yesterday morning. Deceased was 76 years old, and appeared to be hearty and vigorous up to the time of his death. He was upon the streets Monday, and appeared to be in usual good health and spirits, but in the evening was taken with a spell of vomiting, which continued until near morning, when Dr. Plummer was called. Later, he grew worse, and Dr. Mitchell was called in, and at 9 o'clock he breathed his last. The immediate cause of death was attributed to heart failure. Mr. Meredith was an old settler in the town and owned some property here. He leaves a wife and several grown children.
