

Alex Stahl, 89, Former Turlock Constable, Dies

TURLOCK—Alex M. Stahl, 89, a former Turlock constable, died yesterday in his Modesto home after a short illness.

Stahl, a native of Auburn, Kan., came here in 1911. He was constable from 1921 to 1932 and also was chief of police for a time.

He operated the Heather Inn Motel in Modesto 27 years. He was a member of the Turlock Lodge, FAM.

He leaves his widow, Jean Stahl of Modesto; a daughter, Nellie Stahl Charley of Turlock; a son, Wilbur B. Stahl of Baltimore, Md.; three brothers, Leon of Auburn, Kan., Lloyd of Burlingame, San Mateo County, and Lewis Stahl of Topeka, Kan.; two sisters, Eva Meredith of Kansas and Mrs. Jim Ely of Oklahoma, and two grandchildren.

Final rites will be conducted at 11 AM Monday in the Norton Mortuary. Interment will be in Turlock Cemetery.
